Together with her boyfriend, Leendert Guiljam, she is now seeking a shared calling in God's Kingdom, and at this writing, it is not yet known what this will entail. Specifically, this means that Lisanne's assignment through the Kimon Foundation will end when she returns to the Netherlands at the end of December.

We are grateful for your support and compassion for Lisanne. We at Kimon also thank her for the work she has been able to do in Romania with all her dedication, faithfulness, and love from her heart. We pray that her work will be a blessing, that the seed of God's Word sown will bear fruit in His time. Will you join us in prayer?

In addition, it is also important for you, as a donor, to know how the finances will be handled. Now that the decision to stop has been made and Lisanne will soon return to the Netherlands, direct debits will be discontinued as of January 1, 2026. We would like to propose that the funds raised for Lisanne to date, but not currently being used for her deployment, be reallocated to another project within Kimon. If you agree with this proposal, you do not need to take any further action.
